To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3', including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. To fill the class, three riders must complete the course. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the finals.

Open to juniors who have not won a blue ribbon in a Medal or Maclay class prior to September of the preceding year. To be shown over a course of not less than eight fences at 3', must include an oxer, and two changes of direction. Two or more tests of the top 4 are required. One rider per horse. To fill a class five must complete the course. Tests 1-18.

Open to juniors who have not won a blue ribbon in a Medal or Maclay class prior to Sept. of the preceding year. To be shown over eight fences at 3' with or without wings. A minimum of twelve, if available, are required to show at a walk, trot and canter. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control. The flat performance to count 50 %.

Boots and conservative colored bandages are permitted in Jumper Phase only.

All classes will be judged on performance, soundness, and manners. Extreme speed will be penalized. Light contact required. The Champion and Reserve Hunter for each division will be calculated using the performance points: 1st -10pts, 2nd -6pts, 3rd -4pts, 4th -2pts, 5th -1pt, & 6th -1/2pt. In addition, only the top four horses awarded points in the over fence classes are awarded points for the under saddle class and half points for the model classes. Regular Conformation Hunters earn full points. All Classics will have a 1st round within the division indicated by an asterisk.
